Calls on the European legislators to uncover legal gaps in order to tackle all kind of child sexual abuse material, be it either real, pseudo or virtual; recalls that pseudo-photographic child pornography is produced by digitally manipulating non-sexual images of real minors to make pornographic material (for example, deepfake pornography), while virtual child pornography depicts purely fictional characters, including drawn (for example, lolicon manga) or digitally (generative Artificial Intelligence gen-AI) generated; recalls that while the existing legislation primarily covers the first category of child sexual material, the later two could escape legislative framework's safeguarding

11 a. Urges online platforms, providers of hosting services and providers of very large online platforms to improve prevention against messages that promote self-determination models free of age-restrictions, in those Member States where there is no such legislation, that would leave minors the impressions they could make irreversible decisions bypassing parental guidance, following the same model these platforms implement in order to combat online hate speech, harassment and other forms of violence, physical or psychological, that could have serious consequences to the minor's physical and mental well-being;
